Curriculum Overview

History— In history we will be learning about Bonfire Night and why we celebrate it.

Science— Our topic is Polar Adventure—we will find out which materials would be best to take on a polar adventure.

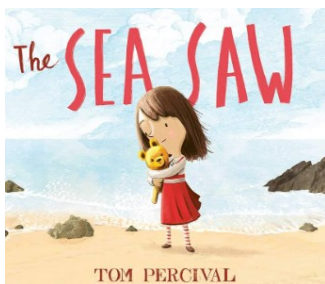
RE and PSHE— We will be learning about the Christmas story. In PSHE we will learn about the importance of looking after our environment.

How to help your child at home

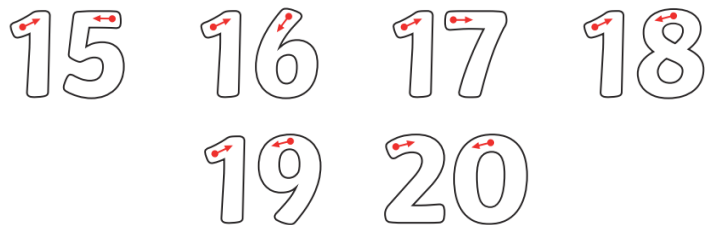


Practicing math's passports at home every day is really important for children to learn and remember key facts that the curriculum demands. Children will be tested every week by an adult in school.
