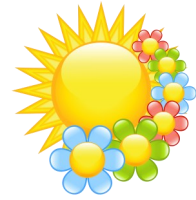

RE—We will be learning about why Jesus is inspiring for some people.

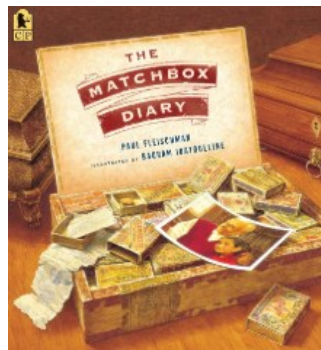
PSHE—We will be looking at how we can be our best.

Class 9 and Class 10 PE is **every Friday** this half term.

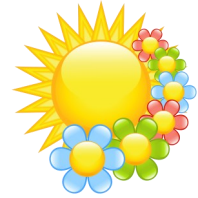
Please ensure full kit is worn to school on this day.

1-2 times a week on Maths Frame will help prepare them for the quick fire conditions of the real test.
