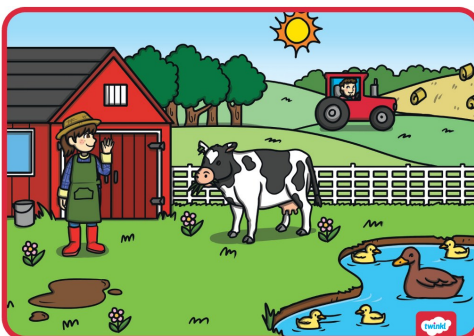


English Homework
